- Request for more visible policing.

- Request for lights at Oxford Road/Upper Richmond Road junction.
- Measures to combat and avoid flooding problems.
- Location of statues forming part of the Putney Sculpture Trail.
- Why No. 22 bus journey is often cut short at Parsons Green.
- Cutting back of trees.
- Dog fouling outside of the animal hospital.
- Litter from free newspapers and glass particles at Lower Richmond Road and Putney High Street junction.
- Number and servicing of motorbikes and scooters outside the Pappa Ciccia Pizza Restaurant in Lower Richmond Road.
- Disturbance in the early hours from recycling collections.
- Concerns over museum plans.
