Summer School (13th July – 5th August)

All courses require some art materials that can be purchased from the school shop. Model fees where applicable are included in the cost, as are charges for inks used in etching and screenprinting.

During week 3 (beginning 27th July) the programme includes courses for young people as well as adults, while courses in the final week (beginning 3rd August) are for Family Learning designed for parents/guardians to attend with a child.

<p>Pottery – AGATE WARE AND INLAID PORCELAIN</p> <p>Tutor: John Dawson</p> <p>For students with some experience. Agate is a very hard stone with patches or concentric bands of colour. Agate ware in ceramics is brought about by introducing coloured clay into the white porcelain clay so you can get an almost marbled effect. On this course we will be looking at different techniques of introducing this coloured clay by either throwing or slabbing then polishing the surface to reveal the various colours. The inlaid work will also use coloured clay but to enhance surface markings.
